Oybek (son of Musa Tashmukhammad) was born on January 10, 1905 in the city of Tashkent. People's Writer of Uzbekistan (1965), Academician of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan (1943). He studied at the Faculty of Social Sciences of the Tashkent University (1925-1927), the St. Petersburg Institute of National Economy (1927-1929), returned to Tashkent due to a serious illness and graduated from the Tashkent University (1930).

Oybek's poetry collections "Emotions" (1926), "Flowers of the Heart" (1929), "Torch" (1932) [1], "Dilbar - Daughter of the Period" (1932), "Revenge" (1933). , "Bakhtigul and He wrote the epics" "Missing in action" (1934), "Girl-heroine" (1936), "Gulnoz", "Archer", "Navoi" (1937) [2]. Nasri Nasri 5 novels (Blessed Blood, 1940; Navoi, 1942; The Sun Does Not Darken, 1943-1959; The Great Way, 1967; (The Glorious Way, In Search of Light). ", "Memories from Childhood" and "Alisher's Child") and a collection of wonderful works [5] reflect the unique events of different periods.

He also translated into Uzbek the poetic novel "Eugene Onegin" by A.S. Pushkin, "Masquerade" by M. Lermontov, "Tartuffe" by Moller.

He died on July 1, 1968 in Tashkent. After his death he was awarded the Order of Honor (2001).

The famous, respected, hardworking writer of the Uzbek people, Oybek was a very tolerant, generous and condescending person. Contemporaries testified that during the years of repression, a critic named Botir Fayziev harshly and unreasonably criticized the writer. The writer, severely hurt in pain, fell ill and eventually lost his tongue. Look at the game of fate, and years later the same critic comes to Oybek and asks him to write a review of his dissertation. The writer forgives him and writes a positive review of his scientific work. There were many such amazing events in the life of the writer.

He knew he was cheating. While Oybek was walking around Moscow with his faithful wife Zarifa, an interpreter from Uzbekistan heard about their tree and visited the hotel. Asks the poet for a loan, saying that he has problems. Then Oybek said: "I had no money. Let's ask Zarifa". Zarifa gives money to the translator with a refund condition. When the translator left, Oybek laughed heartily. His wife asked, "Why are you laughing?" When asked, the writer said, "He won't give you any more money back. He has deceived me a lot before". Zarifa's lamented: "If he does not return the money, we will suffer! Why didn't you say this earlier?". Oybek laughed and said: "I told you to see that he lied to you!"

Minister of literature. For some time Oybek was the chairman of the Writers' Union, and it was a turbulent year. Once he was summoned to the Ministry of the Interior.

- Why don't you tell about the nationalists among the writers in time? - Suddenly the head of the department begins to pester the writer.

- I am a writer. "This is not my job," the chairman replied calmly.

Leaving the office, Oybek said to the assistant chief: "Tell your boss." If he is a minister in his field, I am a minister in literature.

What Oybek? One day Oybek came to the Writers' Union and saw that people were gathering around a poster. Oybek approached them with curiosity and asked:

"What happened?" What did they write?
